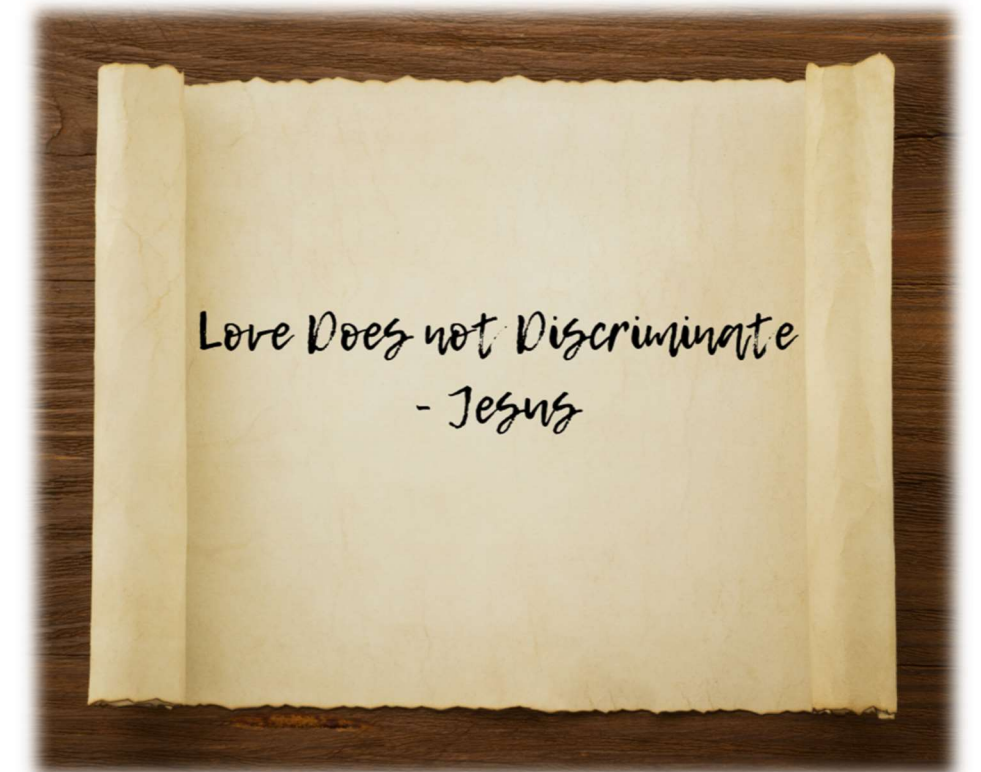
First Baptist Church, along with other churches in the area, helps to make this event a success.
